Re: Information for Candidates

1. <u>Election Details</u>: The election of two (2) members of the Board of Education for three (3) year terms from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2026 will take place on Tuesday, May 16, 2023, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. The polling place is in the high school building.

Note: Because there was a vacancy on the Board that was filled by an appointment, that person only serves until May 16, 2023 and there is an unexpired term from May 16 and until the Annual Organizational Meeting in July. The Education Law states that under these circumstances the candidate who receives the highest number of votes will automatically receive the unexpired term, from May 16, 2023 to the date of the annual organizational meeting in July. This means that this person will be sworn in to the 6+ week term prior to the full three-year term, and will then take the office again in July for the full three-year term.

Legal Qualifications for Candidates:

To qualify for membership on the school board an individual:

- Must be able to read and write.
- Must be a qualified voter of the district; that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age, and not adjudged to be an incompetent.
 - (Note: a convicted felon is barred from running for a seat on a school board if their maximum prison sentence has not expired or if they have not been pardoned or discharged from parole.)
- Must be and have been a resident of the district for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one year immediately before the election.
- May not have been removed from any school district office within the preceding year.
- May not reside with another member of the same school board as a member of the same family.
- May not be a current employee of the District.
- May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office.
- 3. <u>Petitions</u>: Attached is a petition to be returned to the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 17, 2023. Each petition shall state the name and residence address of the candidate, shall state the residence address of each signer, and shall require at least 25 signatures of qualified voters. Please allow ample signatures in case some are illegible or non-residents. Given names should be used (e.g., Mary Smith, not Mrs. Smith). A P.O. Box may not be used as a residence address.

- 4. Requirements for Signing Nominating Petitions Must be a qualified voter of the School District:
 - A citizen of the United States
 - At least 18 years old
 - A resident of the school district for at least 30 days immediately prior to the election at which they seek to vote
- 5. <u>Publicity</u>: The District publicizes the election and provides the required legal notices to the Gannett Newspaper and Rivertowns Enterprise. Names of people who request petitions will be released to the public and media upon inquiry. Nominating Petitions are public documents and will be released upon request.
- 6. Position on Ballot: New York State Education Law specifies that the determination of position of candidates' names on the ballot be done by a drawing. This will take place in the Board Room of the District Administration Building on Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. Candidates may be present or name a designee by written proxy if they cannot be present and must indicate how they wish their name printed on the ballot. If the candidate is not present in person or by a person designated in a written proxy to accomplish the drawing, the District Clerk is authorized to act as proxy (Ed Law Section 2032(2)(b).

7 Expenditure Statements:

- All candidates must file an expenditure and contribution statement at three (3) separate times. The first must be filed on or before the thirtieth (30th) day prior to the election (April 17th) and must cover the entire period up to the day before the filing. A second statement must be filed on or before the fifth (5th) day prior to the election (May 11th) and must cover the entire period up to the day of filing. A third statement must be filed within twenty (20) days following the election (June 5th) and must also cover the entire period up to the day immediately preceding its filing. Candidates must also report, within 24 hours, contributions and loans in excess of \$1,000 received by the candidate within five (5) days before the election.
- The campaign expenditure and contribution statements must be completed, signed by the Board Candidate and notarized by a notary public.
- Candidates whose expenditures and contributions in connection with their nomination and/or
 election total \$500 or less need only file a simple sworn statement to that effect with the District
 Clerk. Candidates whose expenditures and contributions exceed \$500 must file a sworn statement
 with both the Commissioner of Education and the District Clerk.
- 8. <u>Electioneering</u>: Law specifies that electioneering is prohibited on the day of the election/vote within 100 radial feet of the entrance(s) to any polling place. This includes all buttons, literature, banners, and posters.
- 9. <u>Candidates' Workshop</u>: The Westchester-Putnam School Boards Association free Workshop for Prospective School Board Members will be held on Thursday, April 13, 2023, via Zoom, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The flyer is attached and candidates should register directly with WPSBA by April 10th.
- 10. <u>School Board Member Training</u>: School board members elected or appointed for a first term must complete within the first year of their term two training courses, one on fiscal accountability and one on the powers, functions and duties of school boards. Each board member must file certificates with the District Clerk demonstrating completion of the training.
