Award Criteria

The JLCW will consider all applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Female
- Current high school junior
- Lives or attends high school in Eastchester, Greenburgh, Scarsdale or White Plains (e.g. students enrolled in Alexander Hamilton High School, Ardsley High School, Dobbs Ferry High School, Eastchester High School, Hastings High School, Irvington High School, Scarsdale High School, White Plains High School, or Woodlands High School)
- Has demonstrated a commitment to volunteerism and/or public service between September 2020 through March 2023

Each applicant must submit the following documents:

- 1. Applicant Information Sheet (attached)
- 2. **Essay** (ranging between 250 400 words in length) describing how the applicant and the organization(s) and/or student group(s) at which the applicant volunteered benefited from the applicant's volunteer work.
- 3. **Letters of reference** from **TWO** organizations and/or student group(s) at which the applicant has demonstrated her commitment to volunteerism. These letters must be provided by the individual responsible for supervision of the applicant's work and must be submitted on the organization's or school's letterhead. Each letter of reference should include the following details:
 - * Description of volunteer activities performed by applicant
 - * Estimate of the number of people impacted by applicant's volunteer work
 - * How the organization and/or student group and/or student body benefited from the applicant's volunteer work
 - * Duration of applicant's volunteer work (start through end dates) and average number of volunteer service hours per month
 - * Average hours per month (if any) that applicant worked at a paying job during the school year
- 4. Letter of reference from applicant's high school guidance counselor.

Review Process

Telephone conferences may be conducted with the applicant, the supervisor(s) and/or the guidance counselor noted on the application. In-person interviews with applicants may be requested.

Award

The JLCW will award up to two scholarships to the top candidates. Each one is for 1000. The JLCW will announce the award recipients in May 2023.
