2. Ms. Darling explained The Question Formulation Technique (QFT). PPLT members divided up into two groups to tackle the Question Focus: **CRS Continues To Increase Student Capacity**

Group 1:

 3. How does this impact traffic? Busing? Safety?**Group 2:**
 1. What would a capital bond project look like?
 2. How has the increased capacity affected day to day learning/operations/safety/recess?
 3. Do we have projections for student enrollment for 5 years, 10 years, etc.?
4. For next meeting, the PPLT members will continue with the next steps of QFT—using questions to establish an Action Plan, Identify Resources, Research—to come up with a proposal.
