Science 8 (If you also have me for LTI, no need to get duplicate supplies.)

One 3-ring binder w/ loose-leaf (needed for notes and handouts). Can be shared with other subjects.

One package of colored pencils (at least 12 colors)

One calculator (simple 4-function or scientific since you are NOT allowed to use a graphing calculator on the state exam or our tests/quizzes)

Small pair of scissors

Ruler (30 cm)

1 roll of scotch tape (on plastic dispenser)

In general you should also have at least a few No. 2 pencils, pens (**non-erasable** black or dark blue), and highlighters for use in class. You should also have index cards (but those can be left at home or carried with you only if instructed/desired.)
