On Election Day 2019, Concord Road students voted to undertake a year-long effort to take informed action to help the environment. Our CRS citizens are now ready to **TAKING ACTION** and begin their first project in this capstone-style initiative - **a community-wide Recycle Right campaign.**

We are proud to announce that the CRS Student Council will be partnering with the Ardsley High School (AHS) Environmental Club and the Village of Ardsley's [Conservation & Environmental Advisory Committee \(CEAC\)](#) on all our campaign efforts.



Our immediate goal is to reduce the amount of waste at CRS by Recycling Right. The Student Council will collaborate with the AHS Environmental Club and lead a school-wide assembly this Thursday to introduce the Recycle Right campaign and the new laws around reducing the use of plastic bags. Overall the campaign will:

- Encourage students to think about how they can create less garbage from their lunch boxes and lunch trays.
- Teach students to better sort their "trash" to reduce, reuse and recycle in the cafeteria.
- Create other opportunities to Recycle Right in school



We also want to help students replicate their school behaviors at home and throughout their community. You will soon start to receive monthly blasts promoting Recycle Right strategies and providing links, tips and other information. Please use these blasts to help your child further their understanding of how to Recycle Right at school and at home.
