Ardsey High School has been subscribing to Turnitin for the past 15 years. Turnitin is a resource used by many secondary schools to encourage academic integrity and prevent plagiarism. It is a secure website through which students submit their work for review. The website will identify similarities to existing published sources and to other student work. It is an effective way to encourage academic honesty as well as help identify unintentional instances of plagiarism. Turnitin is also a versatile tool that can provide students the resources to produce more academically sound writing.

Turnitin prides itself on ensuring that its services fully comply with FERPA and COPPA. It is necessary for students to sign up for the Turnitin service in order for teachers to adequately authenticate student work. *Parental consent or the consent of a guardian is now required for a minor to set up an account with Turnitin. Students will be using this service for all four years of high school.*
