



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#### **Formalized Data Collection - Qualitative and Quantitative:**

Focus Group - approx. 65: students, parents, administration, board trustees

**Survey** - 1,206 respondents:

students 257 (21%), parents 787 (65%),

faculty/staff 185 (15%), & community 43 (4%)
