Insurance Coverage

This program applies to students who received a brand new device.

The Ardsley UFSD has partnered with Worth Ave. Group to offer an affordable insurance program for school-issued student devices for the 2022-23 school year. The insurance is optional, however, it is highly recommended. Worth Ave. Group provides a high level of affordable service that is coordinated through the district so that families do not have to be involved in handling claims for damaged devices covered by the insurance.

The pricing for the 2022-2023 school year is **\$30.00**.

Insurance must be purchased within the 30-day window at the start of the school year. **Enrollment Deadline: October 16, 2022.** For situations where insurance has not been purchased for a Chromebook that is damaged or lost, families will be held responsible for the cost of replacement or repair of the stolen/damaged device. In the event a student cracks the screen, families will be invoiced \$150 to cover the cost. Students will be given a loaner device for use at school until the problem is resolved.

Insurance with Worth Ave. Group will protect the Chromebook against:

- Accidental Damage
 - Cracked Screens
 - Liquid Spills
 - Liquid Submersion
- Theft/Burglary/Robbery (with a police report)
- Fire/Flood Damage
- Vandalism
- Natural Disasters
- Power Surge Due To Lightning

The insurance policy does not cover the following situations:

- When a student has lost their Chromebook and/or its' accessories,
- Damage caused by intentional misuse or abuse, or cosmetic damage.
