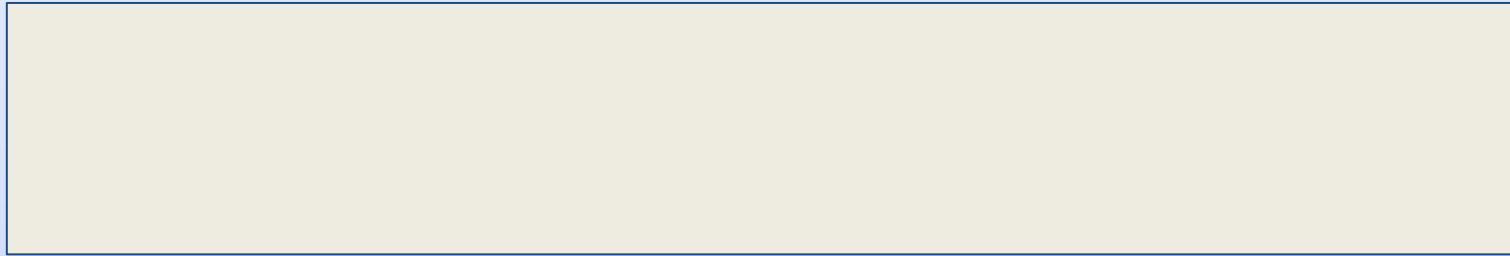
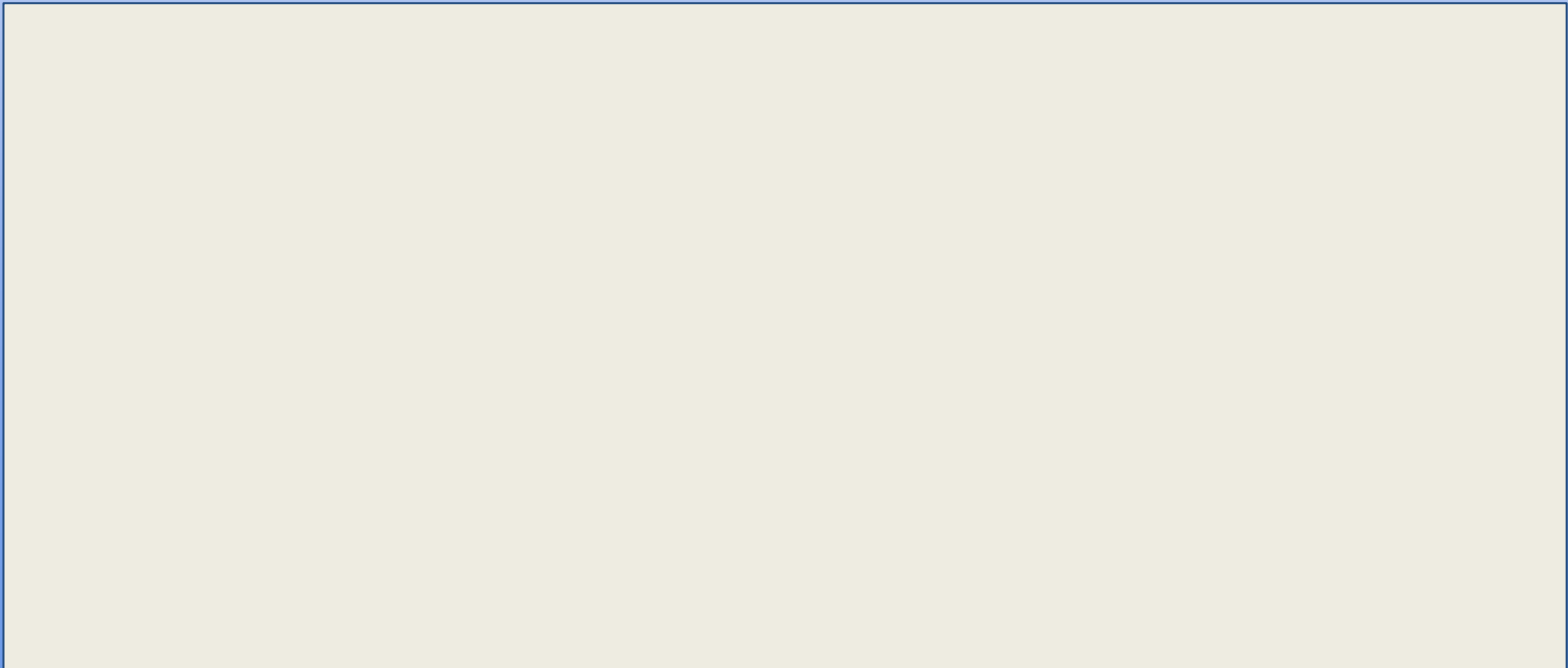

Overview of No Place for Hate

- Developed by the Anti-Defamation League to empower people to challenge bigotry in their communities and schools
- To become a designated No Place for Hate School, schools must:
 - Sign the Resolution of Respect, committing to combat bias, foster harmony, and be kind to all
 - Form a committee to oversee the program
 - Complete 3 or more programs or activities that promote appreciation of diversity

STEP TWO

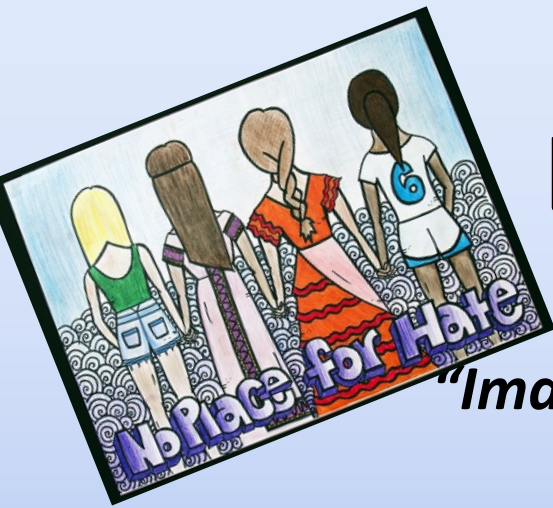
- Follow the resolution every day, in school, and out!

STEP THREE

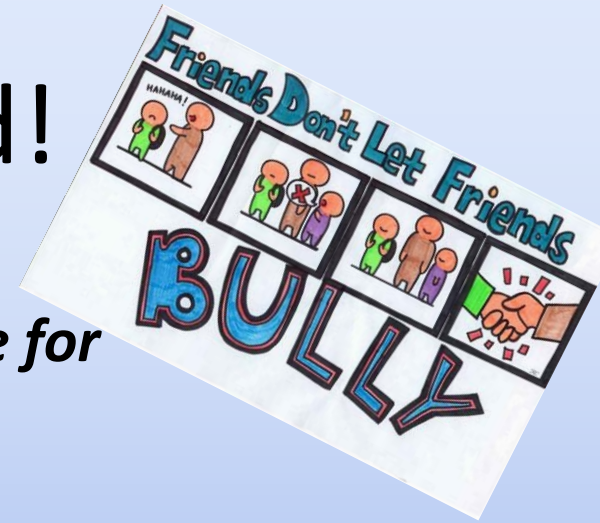
- If you want to do more, join the No Place for Hate Committee
