Re-Entry Task Force

Goal/Charge:

The charge of the Re-Entry Task Force is to design a comprehensive set of recommendations to allow our schools to reopen in September. These recommendations must:

- Meet the safety and the instructional needs of all students, faculty and staff
- Work within Budget guidelines
- Provide flexibility to adjust to changing requirements from the state

Three Possible Scenarios:

- School buildings/campuses do not open and/or need to close for 2 weeks up to 2 months at a time.
- 2. School buildings/campuses open with social distancing ("Split Attendance")
- 3. School buildings/campuses open and business as usual

Re-Entry Task Force

Considerations:

- Our best thinking is that we plan for Hybrid Learning model
 Scenario 1 and Scenario 2 to begin in September, but this target changes as the pandemic "curve" develops.
- Scenario 3 is unlikely without a vaccine or other robust medical intervention.
- Health & Safety at the forefront
 - Testing and Contact Tracing
 - Needs of vulnerable students and staff




